### School Schedule through COVID-19 Pandemic

Since students must go straight to their classrooms when arriving and trying to reduce cohort mixing and providing safe busing, the following schedule has been created:

#### School Arrival

First Buses Arrive @7:45am (We can call this Group A)

Parent Drop Off 7:45-8:15am

Second Buses Arrive @8:15am (Group B)

Students arriving in class will focus on a combination of non-core activities or independent learning activities (AR Reading, Lexia, I-Ready, etc.)

8:20- First bell rings

8:25- School starts with all students

#### School Dismissal

12:50- TK and Kinder dismissal for first trimester

2:00- Group A dismissed to load buses for 2:10 departure

2:15- Parent pick-up time

2:45- Group B dismissed for 2:55 departure or to SERRF

Students in Group B will do similar tasks as identified with Group A upon arrival.

Core academics will take place between 8:25-2:00. Our main focus will be Language Arts and Math. Science and social science will be taught but our main focus will be catching students up in ELA and Math and getting them to grade level. Students will also have a Physical Education rotation with a focus on activities where social distancing can be maintained. Physical education will take place outdoors if at all possible. If the gym is used, sanitation will take place between classes.

Middle school classes will be self-contained until further notice. Mr. Spanger will teach Mrs. Hickok's 8<sup>th</sup> graders Math.

**Recess, Breakfast and Lunch Rotations**

In order to limit class mixing and contact tracing, a schedule has been created for limited students on the playground during break times. Lunch will be eaten outside as much as possible and in classrooms when necessary. We are strongly considering TK and K students eat lunch inside the cafeteria because of their ability to carry trays for long distances. Social distancing with one class is attainable in the cafeteria. Picnic tables and cafeteria tables will be sanitized between classes using the area. While it is heartbreaking that students in different classes will not be able to play together, a schedule was created where a primary class, an intermediate grade, and older grade will be grouped together. There will be designated areas on the playground where classes must stay within those boundaries.

Breakfast- Breakfast will be delivered to classrooms at a teacher's requested time.

Lunch- Broken into approximately 15 minutes of eating time and 15 minutes of recess time. There is a five minute time between classes for sanitation purposes.
